



World Women's Legacy Fund

The World Women's Legacy Fund was created as in 2007 from funds generated by the World Women's Hockey Championships for the purpose of promoting amateur hockey in Manitoba, in particular supporting player development (but not limited to) projects providing:

- (a) On-ice skill development for players
- (b) Introduction to the game
- (c) Training and other off-ice development
- (d) Promotion and retention for current players

This fund is directed towards, but not limited to development of female hockey projects.

WHO CAN APPLY?

All organizations that are recognized as members in good standing of Hockey Manitoba are eligible to apply. A maximum of one application may be submitted per year by an organization.

HOW WILL POTENTIAL FUNDING BE ALLOCATED?

The World Women's Legacy Fund will support projects that are consistent with the purpose for which the Fund was established (see above) and that **DO NOT DUPLICATE OR REPLACE existing applicant programs.**

- Projects will be considered and funded up to a maximum of \$10,000.
- Hockey Manitoba will fund up to 50% (maximum), Applicant must fund 25% of project (minimum)
- Hockey Manitoba funding + Applicant funding – total budget = amount chargeable to participant
- 50% of approved funding to be distributed prior to event and 50% upon receipt of final report
- A higher rate of funding may be considered if participant fee is not reasonable

PROJECT EVALUATION:

Projects will be screened to ensure applicants and projects meet the criteria as set out above. Please note that the number of applications received will be considered when allocating potential funding. Funding for ongoing projects may be reduced in years subsequent to the original application. Additional factors reviewed to determine which projects to fund and level of funding are as follows:

- a) Emphasis on participant recruitment and/or retention
- b) Effect on long term development
- c) Project originality
- d) Number of participants
- e) Level of educational or technical components

APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare and submit a completed application form addressing evaluation factors listed above
- Maintain accurate records on project revenues and expenditures
- Provide a final report no later than 8 weeks after the event

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Applications are scheduled to be reviewed twice per season with the following deadlines:

August 15th **Projects scheduled between September 1st – December 31st**
December 15th **Projects scheduled between January 1st – April 30th**
